



WHO WANTS TO BE A MILLIONAIRE? VIDEO POKER LIVE

GAME IN SHORT

Step into the world of **Millionaire Video Poker Live**, where players can partake in a multi-handed variant (up to 100 hands!) of the classic video poker.

With the addition of an optional side bet to further add to the thrill, players are presented with an exciting opportunity to enter the Millionaire bonus game and increase their winnings, with Multipliers up to an incredible x2,000!

The Millionaire bonus game boasts the familiar **lifelines**, such as 50:50, Ask the Host, and Ask the Audience.

UNIQUE KEY FEATURES

FIVE-CARD DRAW POKER BASE GAME
Based on five-card draw poker, Millionaire Video Poker is similar to the classic video poker game.

After players select number of hands and bet per hand, they are dealt five cards, out of which they can discard one or more and exchange these for new cards.

MILLIONAIRE BONUS GAME
Players can add this optional side bet which allows them to participate in a chance to enter the Millionaire game if a certain combination is achieved within the ten cards dealt.

GAMEPLAY IN BRIEF

BASICS

Players start by selecting the Video Poker payable, number of hands and bet per hand. Once the game starts, the dealer deals five initial cards and players can choose up to five to hold. The choice of cards to hold extends to the main and all virtual hands.

After this, five more cards are dealt and the winning combination is determined. Cards are then dealt to all virtual hands. And the total win is shown.

MILLIONAIRE BONUS GAME

Bets qualify for the Millionaire bonus game, if the player placed a Millionaire bet during the betting round. The four highest cards are selected from the ten cards dealt by the dealer.

If the combination matches one of the Millionaire game combinations, the bonus game is triggered.

The Millionaire bonus game is a quiz bonus round where the player must guess the highest Multiplier in each question.

Depending on the level triggered, there will be up to ten questions. Each one has action time where the player will choose one of the four possible options. After action time ends, answers reveal the Multipliers.

The Millionaire bonus game comes with the familiar lifelines: 50:50, Ask the Audience and Ask the Host.

All the Multipliers are added up and awarded in the end of a game.
